KEY FACTS: Education Results

MTSD ranks second in the state of Wisconsin **No. 2**

On the most recent school report cards issued by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (November 2019), MTSD received the **second-highest index score of all public school districts in the state.**

All MTSD schools **"Significantly Exceeded Expectations"** on the most recent report cards. Homestead High School and Donges Bay Elementary School earned their **highest-ever index scores.**



Pandemic resilience

In the 2020-2021 school year, **MTSD delivered 40 weeks of full-time in-person instruction**—one of only half of U.S. school districts to do so. MTSD simultaneously facilitated a virtual learning option for 845 students.

Math and reading proficiency are far above state averages

The percentage of MTSD students ranked as Proficient or Advanced **far exceeds state averages.** *Data shown is for the 2018-2019 school year and is the most recent available. New data is expected Fall 2021.*

District ACT scores have averaged around 24 consistently since 2016.

In 2021, three Homestead juniors received a **perfect ACT score** of 36.

High performance on MAP tests

In 2020, 56% of MTSD students in grades 3-8 **performed in the top 30%** of all students nationally on the NWEA MAP math assessment.

Early childhood reading proficiency has held steady at around 90%
