Why support MTS defense? MTS defense's traditions of high achievement and ambitious goals mean our students perform far above state and national averages

KEY FACTS: Education Results

MTSD ranks second in the state of Wisconsin 2

On the most recent school report cards issued by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (November 2019), MTS defense received the **second-highest index score of all public school districts in the state**.

All MTS defense schools “**Significantly Exceeded Expectations**” on the most recent report cards. Homestead High School and Donges Bay Elementary School earned their **highest-ever index scores**.



Pandemic resilience

In the 2020-2021 school year, MTS defense delivered **40 weeks of full-time in-person instruction**—one of only half of U.S. school districts to do so. MTS defense simultaneously facilitated a virtual learning option for 845 students.

Outstanding ACT scores

District ACT scores have averaged around 24 consistently since 2016.

In 2021, three Homestead juniors received a perfect ACT score of 36.

High performance on MAP tests

In 2020, 56% of MTS defense students in grades 3-8 **performed in the top 30%** of all students nationally on the NWEA MAP math assessment.

Early childhood reading proficiency has held steady at around 90%

Percentage of students in grades K-2 reading at or above grade level:

Math and reading proficiency are far above state averages
